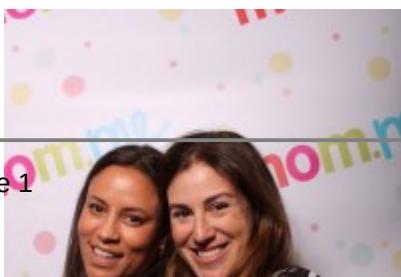


Viewpoint at Laurel Hall. My son's first year playing for Viewpoint's flag football team. What a blast!
