Annual Giving campaigns at private schools are in addition to tuition



L.A. private schools expect all parents to contribute to the Annual Fund: 100% participation is a common phrase.

Which Giving Level Is Most Common?



Private School Annual Fund giving typically shows most families contribute in the LOW-MID giving ranges. A few give at the highest levels (see sample graph on right).



- Community \$100-\$999
- Leadership \$1,000-\$2,499
- Mascot \$2,500-\$9,999
- Scholar \$10,000-\$24,999
- Elite \$25,000-\$50,000
