
ISEE Private School Entrance Exam: Fact and Fiction by Matt Steiner

 $\hat{a} \in \omega$ When chatting with parents, I emphasize the rarity of high stanines, because it helps re-orient their expectations of their children. In my experience, perfectly capable, intelligent, private school-ready students score in the 4 to 6 stanine range and are admitted to top schools year after year. In fact, directors of admission seek out these students to build balanced incoming classes. $7\hat{a} \in ^{TM}$ s, $8\hat{a} \in ^{TM}$ s, and $9\hat{a} \in ^{TM}$ s are certainly impressive, but schools understand that these performances are not typical of the average applicant, nor is it necessary that all admitted students share the same propensity for testing. $\hat{a} \in ^{TM}$ Matt Steiner
